One set should be attached to the form and will become part of your permanent file. The other set should be used to present to the U.S. Embassy or Consulate. Photocopied, faxed and scanned documents are not acceptable forms of verification.

All applicants must show proof of finances. Please obtain an official letter from the bank or financial institution in which you, and /or your sponsor, have available funds. This letter should be written on official letterhead, in English, and signed by a bank official. This letter should state the date the account was open, the currency types and specifically states an amount that is currently in the account. Bank letters dated more than two months from the date of submission to the Montessori Training Center of Minnesota are considered expired. If dependents will accompany you, please use the three summer figure plus the additional cost of dependents.

Parents or sponsors must also provide a letter of commitment (an affidavit). This letter must include your full name, the relationship between you and the sponsor, the amount and duration of their support, and the sponsor's original signature. The sponsor(s) must include their telephone number and address.

Organizations (government or private) sponsoring you must provide a letter of sponsorship on official letterhead with the organization's address, telephone and fax number, and the original signature and title of the responsible official. This letter should also include your full name, the specific dollar amount and duration of sponsorship.

\$2400 due on or before June 1, 2012

*Once all documents are secured, an 1-20 will be issued to the student. This 1-20 will be issued for each summer session and the seminar dates as given in the Elementary brochure. International students will be expected to return home during the academic year in between training. Failure to pay tuition on time will result in termination of 1-20 record and denial of entrance to the United States for the upcoming session.
